Interior designs and layouts are key elements when deciding which superyacht to purchase

When you visit a Yacht Show and see a row of Superyachts moored at the quay, you hardly see the exterior such as the front and sides of the ship, but mainly the back, the stern. You walk over the gangway to the main deck, behind which the Main salon is located.

Your first impression determines whether you want to see the rest of the yacht.

If you like contemporary interiors, art integration and sculptural, light-filled spaces, relaxed interior, and you look at an excessively Ikea-like style, overly dark classical colours or a too busy interior, you won't feel at home. The interior should represent your lifestyle.

You ask yourself how is the layout, what are the colour combinations, and which materials have been used? Is there any artwork present? Does it give a classy impression, are there comfortable seats, luxurious cabinets, how is the connection to the aft deck, what would you want to change, etc.



Personally I believe that the interior should be a combination of comfortable preferences and functionality; after all, what good is a beautiful chair if it isn't comfortable to sit on?

Moreover, the style and quality of the salon's interior is carried through to the other rooms, such as the Master, VIP, Guest rooms, and hallways. If the aft deck and salon meet the criteria, then you will continue to review the yacht; otherwise, the next yacht will be up for consideration. Does it work that way for you as well?

The layout and design of the aft deck (pool area, beach club, seating areas, bar, etc.) and the salon (dining area, TV corner, bar, furniture and seating areas) have a major influence on the decision-making process when purchasing the yacht.
